## New House Construction Nears Completion

### Brother Issues Challenge to Help Reach \$1 Million Goal

It seems like a long time since we started on the road to building our new house, and the end is near! To date we have raised \$745,665 and are on our way to the \$1 million goal, but we are not there yet.

**Richard Wolfe '71, HP 197** has generously offered a challenge gift of \$25,000 if we can raise \$75,000 in new pledges by Homecoming. We have had several new pledges recently, and the in-kind gifts have been numerous. With the announcement of Brother Wolfe's challenge gift, we hope to gain the momentum we need to reach the \$1 million mark.

At this point, our plan is to do a mortgage for \$350,000 over 15 years and pay the balance with cash and a short-term note for pledges receivable. If we raise \$1,000,000 for the project cost, we are okay. If our construction costs exceed this amount, we will need new pledges to cover the overage. We are building a very fine home and are including some features that will no doubt require more money, but I have faith that your support will be there.

We still have named gift opportunities available. If you are interested, please let me know. All naming rights are reserved for individual gifts, except for bedrooms. We have 11 bedrooms with a naming right of \$10,000. We plan

to allow joint gifts toward this naming opportunity with a limit of four people per room (e.g., 4 @ \$2,500 each). The 12th bedroom known as the "tree house," an amazing room for two, will require a larger gift.

All new gifts to the campaign should be made to the WKU Foundation and may be tax deductible. You will receive recognition from WKU, as well as the chapter, for your gift.

There are many brothers who have yet to contribute, while others have increased their initial pledges, so let me encourage all Sigma Nus in *Honoring Our Past, Securing Our Future* on the hill at WKU. Anything you can do to allow us to finish this campaign by Homecoming will be greatly appreciated and will help us maximize Brother Wolfe's generous challenge gift!
